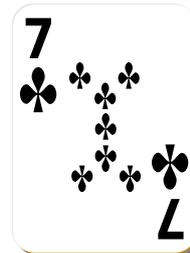
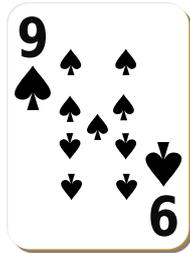
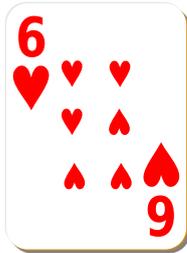

→ for a number to be odd the last digit must be odd
